

THE HOUSE OF COMMONS OF CANADA.

BILL 12.

An Act to incorporate the Great West Fire Insurance Company.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying that Preamble.
it be enacted hereinafter as set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. Edward Lindsay Elwood, John F. L. Embury, Walter B. Scott and Wilson M. Graham, all of the city of Regina in the province of Saskatchewan, solicitors, together with 10 such persons as become shareholders in the company, are hereby incorporated under the name of the "Great West Fire Insurance Company," hereinafter called "the Company." Incorporation.
Corporate name.
2. The persons named in section 1 of this Act shall be 15 the provisional directors of the Company. Provisional directors.
3. The capital stock of the Company shall be one million dollars, which may be increased to two million dollars. Capital stock.
Increase.
4. The amount to be subscribed before the general meeting for the election of directors is called shall be two 20 hundred and fifty thousand dollars. Subscription before election of directors.
5. The head office of the Company shall be in the city of Regina, in the province of Saskatchewan. Head Office.
6. The Company may carry on the business of fire insurance, the business of cyclone or tornado insurance and hail 25 insurance, and the following classess of business as defined by section 2 of *The Insurance Act, 1910*, namely: explosion Business authorized.
