

Governor-General and one or more ladies of his household.

1. Persons subscribing One Dollar (\$1.00) annually shall be members of the Guild and shall have one vote each at all General Meetings. The Guild shall have the right to reject persons whom they shall deem undesirable.

2. Council Members may be elected by the General Committee from the members of the Guild. The term "Council Members" means those members whom the General Committee consider will be of assistance to the Guild on account of the value of their advice and personal influence.

3. Any person who contributes to the general funds of the Guild the sum of fifty dollars (\$50), or a gift in kind equivalent thereto in the estimation of the General Committee, or any person indicated in his stead by such contributor, may be elected by the General Committee a life member of the Corporation; but this amount of qualification may be increased by the General Committee.

Non-residents may be elected honorary members at the discretion of the General Committee.

ARTICLE IV.

OFFICERS AND COMMITTEES.

1. A General Committee of twenty-two members shall be elected at the Annual Meet-
