WILSON HORSES RAN 1-2
MICHAELMAS HANDICAP

Young Morpheus and Bello Win the Steeplechases—Four Favorites on Third Day.

Conditions were ideal for the third day of the Ontario Jockey Club's fall meeting, except that there was a chill in the air, but the sun was shining brightly. The attendance was up to the average and the racing all that could be desired. The fields were small in three events and large the rest. The Michaelmas Handicap, the first feature of the program, resulted in a decisive victory for R. T. Wilson, Jr., who ran 1-2 with his royally bred pair of two-year-olds, Aldebaran and Penobscot, presumption from the stable of J. McManus.

Favorites had the call all the day, four rewarding the public at even money or better. Kilo, Young Morpheus and Dr. Holberg were second and third choices. Moonraker, with Bello in the saddle, finished second in the opening event and paid the largest price of the day, \$2 yielding \$43.70 for the place.

R. T. Wilson, Jr., was the winning owner with two firsts, while Wilson and McManus divided first jockey honors with two each.

Kilo was first to show in the opening event and he stayed in front for a win by two lengths. Old Moonraker, who was in fine form coming from behind for the place, came in second. Commela was fourth ahead of Bursar, the favorite that killed himself trying to catch the leader. C. A. Crew did up the winner to \$700 and took him.

His Reverence, favorite, fell in the first steeplechase and then it was a procession. Young Morpheus first, Broadword second, and St. Boneta third, the entire distance. His Reverence was so badly shaken up that he hardly ran again this year. Naushon, favorite, lay in behind for 1 1/2 in the Sandingham Handicap and then ran over the three, Bob R. second and Cliff Edge third, all strung out in slow time.

The Wilson pair ran 1-2 in the \$3500 Michaelmas with Aldebaran and Penobscot performing impressively, the

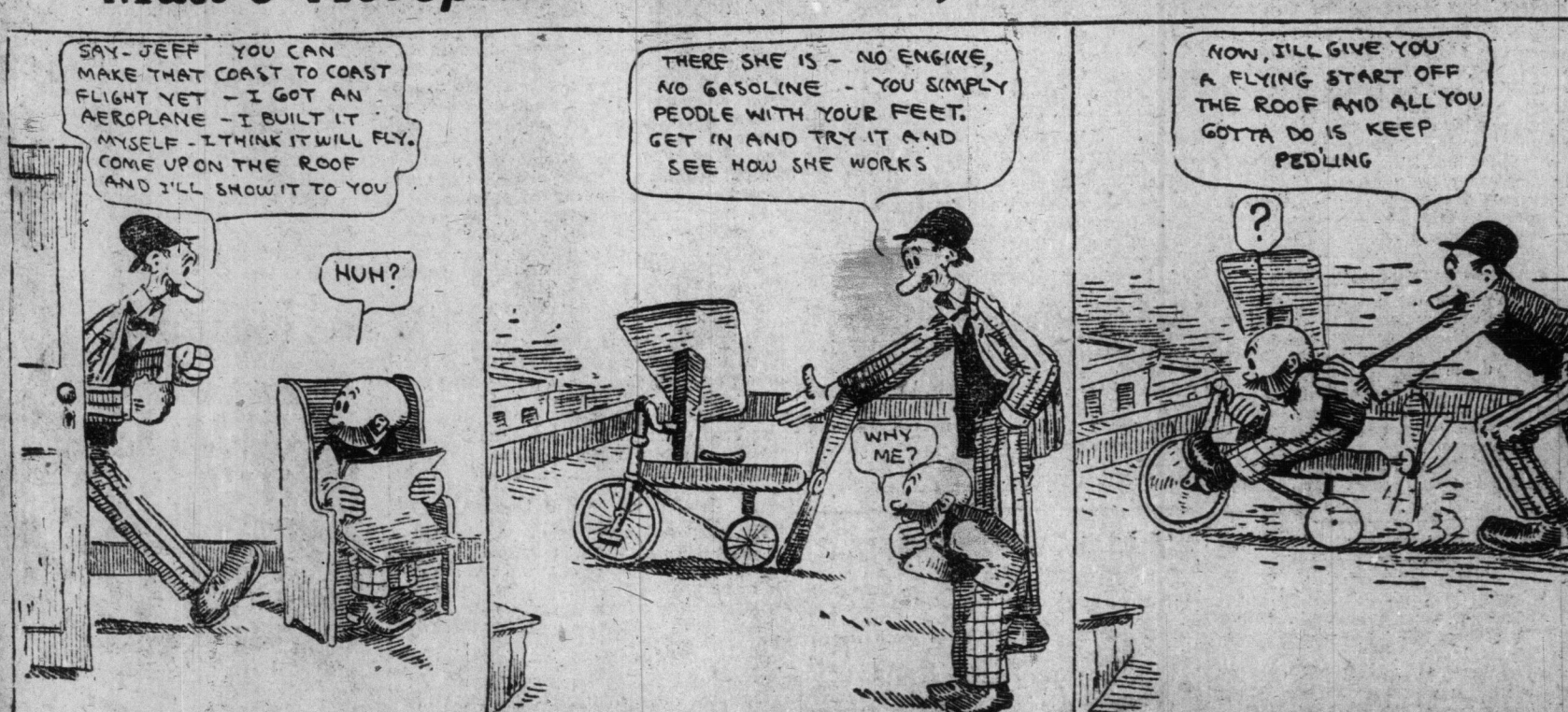
