Jury Return Verdict on All Three Counts - End of Famous

Savannah, Ga., April 12.-Greene and Gaynor were to-day found giulty on all three indictments, the jury returning its verdict at 1.55 p.m. Judge Speer ordered a recess until to-morrow, when sentences will be imposed. The maximum sentence that the court may impose under the law is an aggregate ter of seventeen years in the peni-tentiary and a fine of \$575,000, the amount of the alleged embezzlement, Judge Speer said before adjourning court to-day: "I have no disposition hours towards these unfortunate men, except to be just as merciful as my duty under

the law will permit."
In discharging the jury, Judge Speer said that no jury in the United States, perhaps in this century, has had a more He added that the jurors had rendered a service likely to be of benefit to the people of the republic in the future.
