DALTON MCCARTHY DEAD

The Member for North Simcoe Succumbs to His Injuries. A GREAT CANADIAN GONE TO HIS REWARD

Wounds Received On Sunday Night Proved to Be More Than Human Strength Could Endure--Regret Expressed in the House at Ottawa by the Premier, Sir Charles Tupper and Others--Death Came Last Evening In Spite of the Best Medical Skill--Physicians' Statements--Sketch of His Career--His Manifold Position--Tributes to His Sterling Character.

The tidings of the death of Mr. D'Alton McCarthy will be received with universal regret this morning.

Of late years Mr. McCarthy derived his principal amusement and exercise from horseback riding, of which he was very fond.

In social circles he was ever welcome, and his geniality and brilliancy were here a conspicuous feature in the highest professional spheres.

On Wednesday morning it was thought that the patient was in a fair way to recovery, but about noon the condition altered.

On Sunday night, it was reported that the patient was better, and was able to sit up in bed.

At ten minutes past 9, however, an sudden gust of wind snuffed out the candle, and the spark of life fled from Mr. McCarthy's frame.

So sudden was the summons that the members of the family had not time to reach the bedside of the dying man.

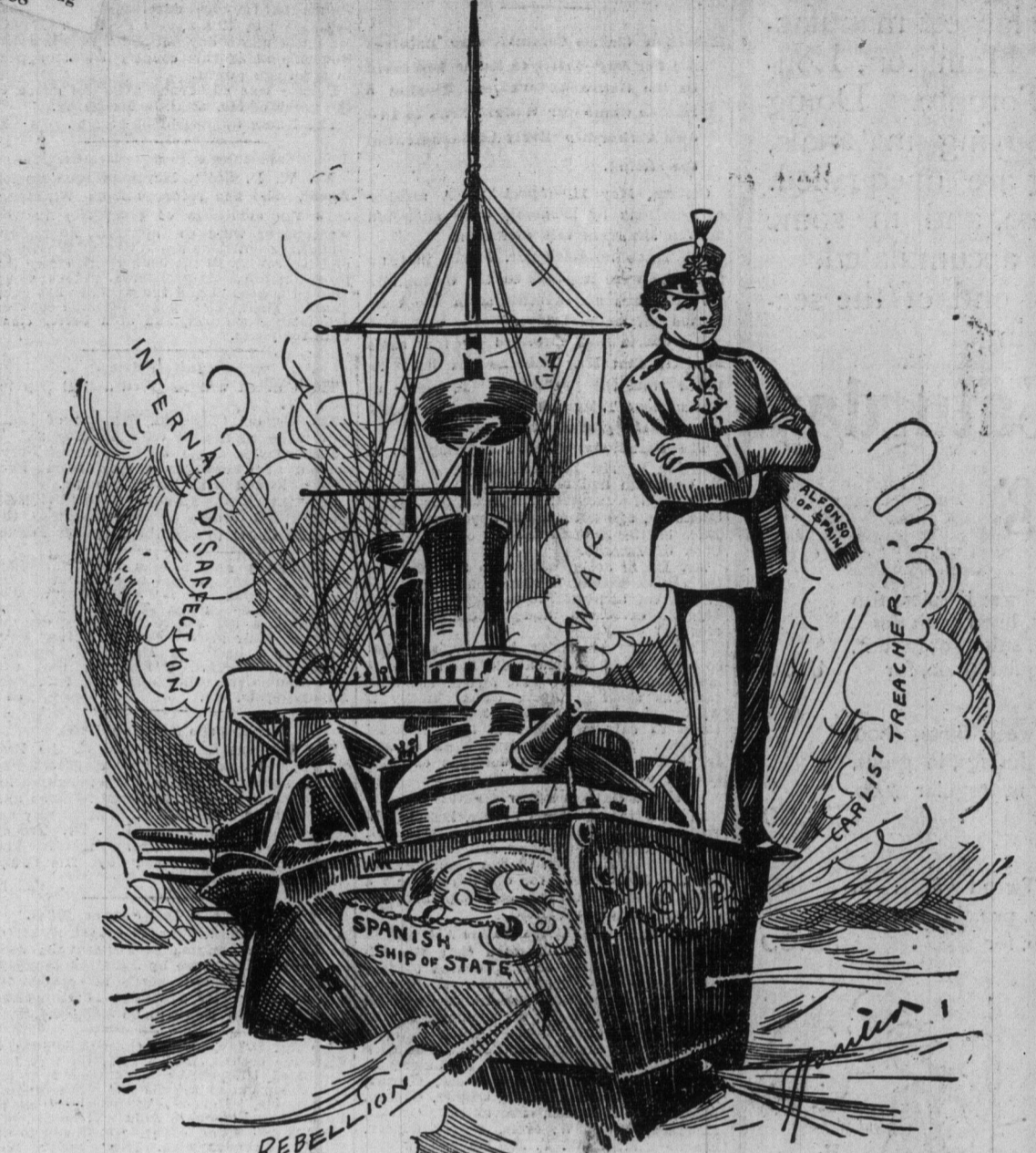
At the autopsy, it was found that the lungs were in a state of catarrh, and that the heart was enlarged.
