

Sir Charles Dilke, in to-day's Chronicle, ventures upon a shrewd explanation of the Anglo-German agreement respecting the Portuguese possessions in East Africa. He contends that there has been an agreement in existence for two years, and that it relates to Delagoa Bay, but that it is what conveyancing lawyers describe as a deed which can have no binding force until it is executed. This is the view which is entertained in diplomatic circles, 'ireat Britain and Germany have arranged a scheme of partition, which will go into effect whenever Portugal is willing to sell out her possessions in that quarter. Portugal does not appear to be in any laste to do this, and consequently the contract for the extension of German East Africa to the Zambesi and the British occupation of Delagoa Bay is in a state of suspended animation.


