WINDSOR, Nov. 28.—In future all members of the Windsor police department must sever all previous political affiliations they may have had, according to a ruling made by Daniel Thompson, recently appointed chief.

He arrived today to look over the territory and secure accommodation for his family before actively assuming his duties on December 15.

Chief Thompson conferred with Mayor Winter, Magistrate Gundy, Judge George Smith and other officials, and was taken for a tour of the border district. General local conditions and the need for a clean-up campaign here were discussed and plans sketched for the coming year.

"In my police experience," Chief Thompson told The Advertiser, "I have found that most trouble comes from idleness. Work is the best cure for crime. I am going to see that no policeman here shall ever be idle in my book of rules. It is policies that have complicated conditions in large cities and in Canada cities, and I'm not going to tolerate any similar condition here. Politics will spill any police force."
