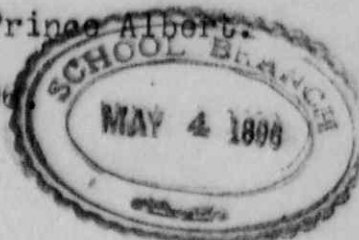

Sir:

I beg to inform you that there is no proper fence between the premises occupied by the boys and the girls at the school here. For obvious reasons it is necessary that there should be such a fence as will ensure so far as may be effectual separation. A good board fence would cost about sixty dollars(\$60.00.) for lumber, posts and nails. As we are straitened for means I would respectfully submit an application to the Department for the above mentioned amount, for the purchase of the material the work to be done by ourselves.
