ITALY OBSERVES FASCIST BIRTHDAY

Review of Troops at Milan is Feature of National Program

MILAN, Oct. 28.—The fourth anniversary of the Fascist march on Rome was celebrated throughout Italy today, but the principal ceremony occurred here, where many were present to review the Fascist forces of Lombardy. Throughout Italy flags were flying and all public buildings were illuminated.

The ceremony here opened with a stupendous military review. The Duce rode a spirited charger and was escorted by his staff.

The leader of Fascism was attired in the uniform of a corporal of honor of the Fascist militia. A striking white sash was draped over his right shoulder, and he wore a black hat adorned with stripes of red. His horse was adorned with a striking red saddle cloth, decorated in the Fascist arms. The Duce wore his decorations and presented a smart military appearance.

All arms of the service were represented.

The variety of services in the Fascist militia proved again that the organization was prepared for any eventuality. There were detachments of machine-gunners, heavy and mountain artillery, chemical outfits, signal corps and mounted troops. The black shirt of traditional fame was worn by all ranks.

The tunic were the same as those of the regular army except that the collar was open. Ware after ware of illumination passed the Duce, saluting in measured precision. The Duce returned the salute with a smart raise of the arm. Roman fashion, which the Fascist militia has used since the beginning.

Following the review, the Duce was driven to the historic Piazza Duomo, where a crowd estimated at 30,000, was awaiting him. This meeting was rendered extremely impressive by the fact that the Duce had given the pledge a year ago to meet his cohorts here today. Frantic cheers greeted the Fascist leader, so that he was unable to proceed with the speech. As he would open his mouth, renewed cheers would sound in the piazza.

The city was beflagged throughout. The illuminations this evening are made after elaborate designs and give copious play to the Fascist coat of arms, the Duce's rods with a background of red, white and green.

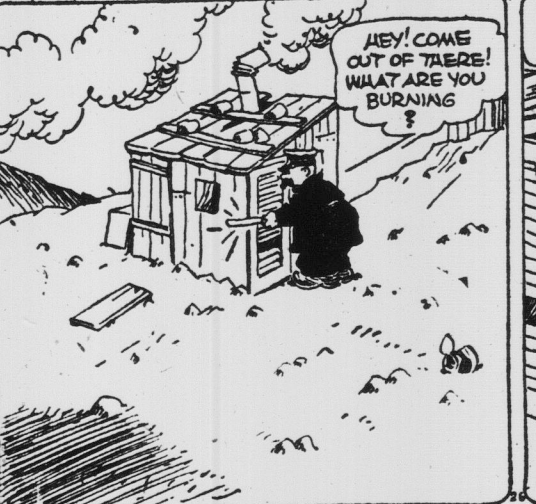

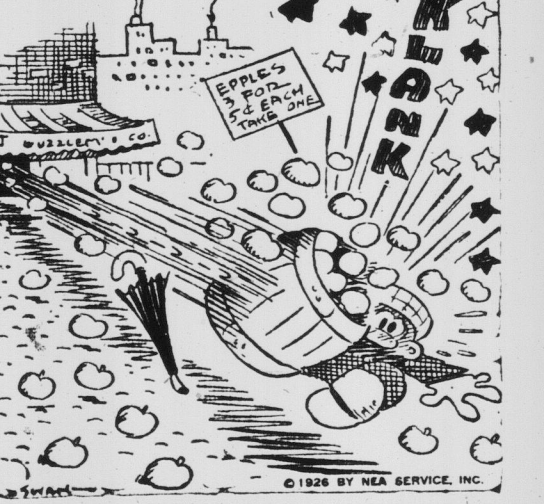
