MILAN, Oct. 28-The fourth anniversary of the Fascist march on Rome was celebrated throughout Italy today, but the principal ceremony occurred here, where many were present to review the Fascist forces of Lombardy. Throughout Italy flags were flying and all public buildings were illuminated. The ceremony here opened with a stupendous military review. The Duce rode a spirited charger and was es-

corted by his staff.

The leader of Fascism was attired in the uniform of a corporal of honor of the Fascist militia. A striking white aigrette shot upward from his Fascist fez-like hat adorned with stripes of red. 


