POCKET RADIO FOR POLICE IS PLANNED

Westchester County, New York, to Have Elaborate Broadcasting Protective System.

New York, Jan. 21.—One of the most elaborate police alarm systems that has ever been established anywhere in the country is being planned for Westchester county, with radio broadcasting as the medium of communication. Preliminary plans are being considered and, if perfected, it is hoped they will make the entire area of Westchester a barred zone for all fugitives and control.

The plan is to establish a central headquarters for reports at Tarrytown radio broadcasting station. From this point all instructions, descriptions of men sought and information of general character will be broadcast.

Unique among the many features is the plan to link not only all the headquarters of the county but every motorcycle policeman and patrolman as well with the central headquarters and the sheriff's office. To make this possible a compact receiving set, said to be of little weight and of such reduced proportions as to make it practicable for each officer to carry on duty with no encumbrance, is being perfected. In addition to this a receiving apparatus is also being designed to be attached to every motorcycle in the various police departments of the county.
