JUBILEE OF MEETING WHICH LED TO THE MAKING OF CANADA

Confederation Celebration Being Planned For Charlottetown—Preliminary Meeting on Dec. 30

(Special to Times)

Charlottetown, P. E. I., Dec. 28.—It was in this city in 1864 that the first confederation conference was held. Then the union of the three maritime provinces only was discussed, but this discussion led to the holding of a greater conference in Quebec, which resulted in the union of Quebec, Ontario, Nova Scotia and New Brunswick in 1867, the island not joining till 1870.

Next September will be the fiftieth anniversary of this memorable event in Charlottetown, and the people here are now discussing the celebration of it. A meeting is called for Dec. 30.
