Daily Hints For the Cook

Plain Cake

One cup sugar, one egg, one cup sour milk, a little salt, one egg, one teaspoon soda, if milk is real sour, if not, a little less; one heaping tablespoon shortening, nutmeg. If you have sour cream use it instead of milk and omit shortening.

Irish Pound Cake

Two cups sugar, one cup shortening (one-half lard and one-half butter), two eggs, one cup sweet milk, four cups flour, 1½ teaspoons cream of tartar, three-quarters teaspoon soda. Flavor to taste. This makes two loaves, not sheets, and is a good foundation for nut, fruit or chocolate cake.
