Daily Hints For the Cook

EGG PLUMS. Dip some hard-boiled eggs for two days in grape juice, to color them; then stick a twig of plum leaves in one end of each. By the use of artificial leaves, one may serve "egg plums" at any season of the year. Serve cold as an hors d'oeuvre.

JAPANESE SALAD. One box of sardines, three gills of rice, a few small mushrooms, French dressing and one cupful of cooked peas. Boil and drain the rice. Mix it with the dressing and cool; keep it in a dish. Drain the oil from the sardines and press them into the rice. Decorate with peas and mushrooms.

GALATINE OF CHICKEN. One fowl, one pound sausage, one cupful of bread crumbs, two hard-cooked eggs, six pickled walnuts, a few pieces of ham, half a cupful of blanched almonds, seasonings of salt, ground lemon rind and herbs. Bone the fowl. Mix sausage with bread-crumbs, seasonings and two beaten eggs. Spread this forcemeat inside the fowl, and lay in the ham, almonds, eggs and walnuts; roll and sew together; roll in a cloth, bind with tape, and boil for two hours in boiling stock. Lift out and put between plates with a weight on top. When cold remove the cloth. Decorate with aspic, hard-cooked eggs and parsley.

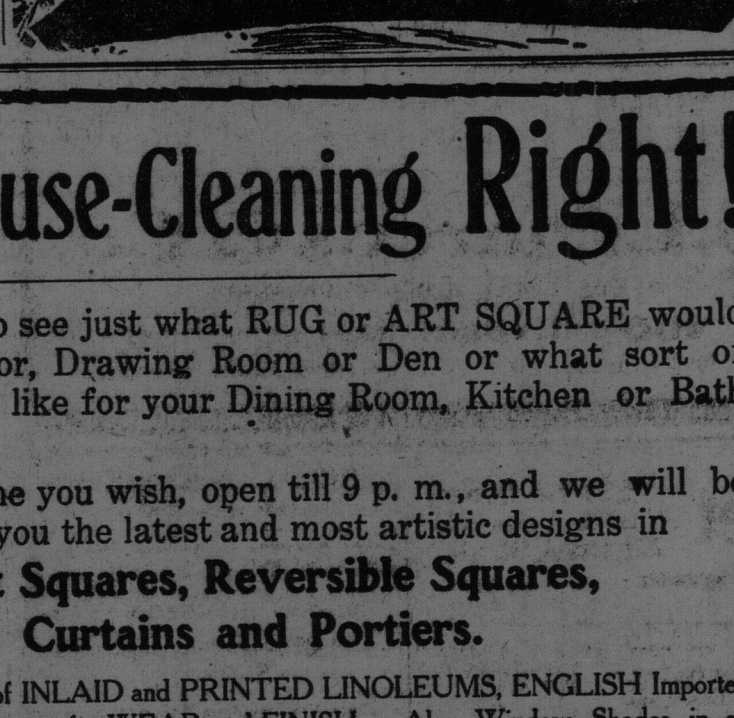
