The Committee, therefore, would respectfully, suggest to religious Societies throughout the Province, whether congregational collections for this end would not be, at once creditable to the characters which they sustain, agreeable to the minds of many of their members, and a sacrifice well pleasing to him whose they are, and whom they serve.
