North Easthope; that, on the 15th of December, 1857, they had accepted the Rev. George Murray's demission of the pastoral charge of the congregations of Blenheim and Burford; that, on the same day, they loosed the Rev. A. A. Drummond from the pastoral charge of the Congregation of Brantford, and that, on the 12th of January, 1858, they had inducted him into the pastoral charge of the congregations of Mornington and North Easthope.

Proceeded to the election of a Moderator.

It was moved by Dr. Ferrier, seconded by Mr. Dick, that the Rev. John Morrison of Madrid, be elected Moderator.

It was moved in amendment by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Coutts, that the Rev. William Aitken of Smith's Falls be chosen Moderator. A vote was taken, and the Rev. Mr. Aitken was declared duly elected, who then took the chair and addressed the Synod.
