Did you sleep there the right of 31 Mar - 1 Apr? I believe I did. A . Was there any period in which you are not in the canteen? Several times during the day it is locked up but no one is there. A . Did you ever leave the accused there alone? Q. Yes, but only to go outside, and I could see him through the window, and besides I always came right back in. A . You never left him alone there in charge? No. IN THE OPINION OF THE COURT IT IS UNNECESSARY TO COMPLY WITH RP 83(B). he said no. Exhibit "A" is the box. There was a name on the box by the name of Duthrie. We took it over to the Orderly Room, opened it, and found it just as it is now. Q. Was Exhibit "B" in the box also?

Sometime ago a Cpl Sherry recd a parcel, I saw him open it, and he treated us, and the accused said he needed the empty box and Sherry said he could have it and gave it to him. I don't know what happened after that. This conversation was in Hut No 9. Sherry is not with us now
