AMENDMENTS TO THE STATUTES.

Moved by V. E. Sir Knight Thomas Sargent, and seconded by R. Em. Sir Knight Wm. Gibson,

To amend Statute 7 by repealing the word "member" on the fourth line from the bottom of said Statute, and to insert the word "Preceptory" in place thereof.

To repeal Statutes No. 38, 39, 40, 41, 42 and 43, and to enact Statutes providing for the election annually of Standing Committees of three members each on Audit and Finance, the State of the Order, on Foreign Correspondence, on Constitution and Laws, on Appeals and Grievances, and on Fraternal Dead, and to define their duties.

To stand over until next annual assembly, owing to the absence of the Grand Chancellor.

RESOLVED,—That Statute 132 be amended by adding after the word "Priory" on the fourth line the words "or shall have been sent to the Grand Chancellor on or before the first day of December preceding the Annual Assembly of Great Priory."

RESOLVED,—That Statute 28 be amended by repealing the words "British Columbia" in section 9, and to enact new sections: 10.—To comprise the Province of British Columbia. 11.—And Great Priory may at any annual assembly, by resolution, establish such further Districts or Provinces as may be required.
