(Circular, No. 1.)

A supply of Great Coats having been received from England for the use of the Volunteer Force, His Excellency the Administrator and Commander in Chief has been pleased to direct that after being marked and numbered they shall be issued as follows:

His Excellency has further directed that the Great Coats shall in future be kept with the Arms in the Armories (Public or Private as the case may be) and worn only with the Arms on duties recognized by Law; and Commanding Officers of Corps and all others concerned will be held responsible that this Order is strictly attended to.

No alteration of any kind can be permitted in these Great Coats; and with a view to further regularity they will be accompanied by a List shewing the number on each—and Commanding Officers are requested to place such number in the "Service Roll" of the Corps opposite to the name of the Volunteer to whom the Great Coat may be appropriated
