VICTORIÆ REGINÆ.

AN ACT to make provision for the Management of the Temporalities of the United Church of England and Ireland, in this Province, and for other purposes therein mentioned.

[Royal Assent Promulgated 3rd December, 1841.]

Whereas it is desired on behalf of the United Church of England and Ireland, in the Province of Upper Canada, that provision should be made by law for the internal management, by the Members of the said Church, of the Temporalities thereof, and also for allowing the endowment thereof; and it is just and expedient that such provision should be made: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Prevince of Upper Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, entitled "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled "An Act for making more effectual
