A Message was brought from the House of Commons by their Clerk, with a Bill intituled: "An Act to amend Chapter 67 of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada, intituled: 'An Act respecting Electric Telegraph Companies,'" to which they desire the concurrence of this House.

Ordered, That further Debate, on the said motion be postponed until the next sitting of the House.

Then, on motion of the Honorable Mr. Campbell, seconded by the Honorable Mr. Mitchell,

The House adjourned until half-past seven o'clock, this evening.
