

XLIV. Any sum or sums of money arising from conviction and recovery of penalties as aforesaid shall be paid to the Treasurer of the Council.

XLV. All notices and documents required by this Act to be sent, may be transmitted by post, and shall be deemed to have been received at the time when the letter containing the same would have been delivered in the ordinary course of post; and in proving such sending, it shall be sufficient to prove that the letter containing the notice or document was pre-paid, and properly addressed and put in the post. Notices and documents may be in writing or in print, or partly in writing and partly in print.

XLVI. The General Council may make representations to the Governor General in Council upon sanitary subjects, and when called upon shall give its opinion respecting matters touching the Public health.

XLVII. The provisions of this Act shall not extend to Manitoba, but as regards that Province or any other that may be hereafter added to the Dominion of Canada, it shall be competent for the Governor General in Council, on the recommendation of the General Council and with consent of such Province or Provinces, to extend the provisions of this Act to such Province or Provinces, the representation in Council of such additional Province or Provinces to be proportionate to that of the Provinces now to be represented by the terms of this Act.

XLVIII. All Acts in the several Provinces of the Dominion of Canada inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed.
