Board reverses no bus decision

Peel County Board of Education Friday reversed a decision made at the Tuesday meeting and agreed to provide bus service for children from Erindale travelling along Dundas to Springfield Public School.

The decision was made following a protest from parents and children that it was extremely dangerous for children walking along Dundas St. where there is no sidewalk.

A group of mothers and children demonstrated outside the board offices on Dundas and later in front of the Mississauga Municipal Building.

The crowd originally began their protest in Erindale, but were reportedly transported to the board of education building in a truck from a Toronto paper, accompanied by a photogra-

The matter of transportation for the Erindale children came up at the regular meeting, and a motion by trustee Dr. Ted Humphreys that the board supply bus service until Mississauga Council acts on the recommendations of the 'safety council was defeated. Also defeated was a recommendation that service be provided regardless of coun-
