I have the honour to report with reference the above Band of Indians, that I visited this Reserve company with the Indian Agent, A.D. McNabb, on the after noon of the 16th., inst., Mr. McNabb had previously informed me that he had received a complaint that the Indians of this Band were making moonshine.

On our arrival, there was a fineral taking place, when this was going on, I visited the homes of the Indians, but could find no trace of liquor and any apparatus suitable for the manufacture of illicit liquo

I made some discreet enquiries and was info that some of the Indians had been drunk on July 1st., I informant stated that he suspected this liquor had comfrom a place named wawa City, a small white settlement about 6 miles from the Mission, after the Agent had paid the Indians their Treaty Money, we proceeded by team wawa City.
