Sir,

Referring to your letter of the 12th instant, I return herewith Dr John R. Stone's account for professional services rendered to Indians of the Parry Island Band for June quarter 1902. The charge of \$4.50 for medicine for Mrs Pavis and also the charge of \$5.25 for medicine for Mrs Hawk are considered excessive, and explanation are required in regard to the same.

Mrs Hawk, Mrs Pavis and Mrs Judge, who according to the account were attended by Dr Stone, do not appear to be Parry Island Indians, as their names ~~do not~~ are not on the pay-list. This also should be explained.

A list of the persons vaccinated should be attached to the account.
