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Ottawa, 23th July, 1903.

Sir,-

Referring to my letter of the 16th inst., I beg to inform you that the permit granted by the Department of the Interior to cut timber on Township 54, Range 15, west of the 3rd Meridian, is limited to the cutting of 2,000 logs only. Under these circumstances it is not considered necessary to have the boundaries of the said Township defined by survey.

I have, therefore, to confirm the telegram sent to you to-day, to the care of J.P.C. Day, Indian Agent at Battleford, Sask., as follows:-

"Do not make any survey of Township 54, Range 15, West of the 3rd Meridian, as instructed by letter of 16th instant".

The instructions sent to you, dated the 16th inst., for the survey of the said Township are, therefore, cancelled.
