
Ottawa, 25th November, 1913.

Sir,—

In reply to your letter of the 19th instant, I beg to say that you may furnish relief supplies to the value of \$5.00 a month of Nancy and Sarah Columbus, who are unable to work. The assistance may date from the beginning of December and continue until April of 1914.

You may also furnish fire wood to the value of \$15.00 to these women. The cost of the supplies furnished will be charged to the Interest Account of the Sucker Creek Band. Expenditure of the above nature is never charged to Capital Funds.
