impress upon him that on Mr. Sawyer's death the property goes at once to the band, and the interest acquired from Mr. Sawyer would immediately seese. On the other hand if Mr. Sawyer should live for a number of years the \$700 might not be sufficient for his maintenance and he would then be without any resources.
