Ottawa, March 26, 1920.

Rev. Sir,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 18th instant in reference to the amount of salary paid you as teacher of the Samson's Indian Day School.

In reply I beg to say that the salaries paid the teachers in the Methodist Indian day schools are arranged between the Rev. T. Ferrier, Superintendent of Methodist Indian Schools, and the Department, and the amount allowed for the teacher of the Samson's Day School is at the rate of \$600.00 per annum. You should refer to Rev. Mr. Ferrier regarding an increase in your present salary.

In reference to the bonus I beg to say that a bonus is allowed to teachers of Indian day schools at the rate of \$150.00 per annum, payable quarterly, for the present fiscal year. You began duties on November 12th and the \$20.60 received by you was the amount of the bonus due for the time you taught during the December quarter. As soon as your returns for the March quarter are received you will be entitled to a further instalment of the bonus of \$37.50.

The cheques for salary are sent to the Treasurer of the Methodist Missionary Society, Toronto.
