Was a member of the District Court Martial held at Dork Point Barracks Esquimaux from the 2nd to the 6th of June 1928 inclusive.

During this period I recorded the whole of the proceedings of this Court Martial. On the 4th of June 1928 the accused, whom I identify here present, in the course of his sworn evidence at this Court Martial produced a letter which he stated had been received at the District Barracks for a Tpr. Hawthorne from one Grace Buchanan.

The accused stated this letter had been withheld by him from Tpr. Hawthorne. This letter is included in the proceedings marked
