half of the value of the manure used will be available for future crops. No credit is given for the undoubted value of the mulch and vites as humus making materials for succeeding crops. Four thousand quarts to the acre is considered a fair average crop in the preceding article. Ten cents per quart is the average net returns received by the writer for the past two years.
