

of the money allotted for the expences of the house where the Society meets, and shall account to the Treasurer. They shall also visit sick Members, at the desire of the President, and report to him. In case of the death of any Member, they shall, if their services are required, give their personal attendance and aid to effect his decent Burial.

Absence of Officers, ART. 7. In the absence of the President, the Vice President shall preside. If they are both absent, the Members present shall chuse a President for the Meeting.

Motions, ART. 8. Every motion made in the Society, shall be in writing and seconded by a Member, after which it shall be delivered to the President to be put to the vote, or lie over, agreeably to the Law and the Rules of the Society: And no motion shall be made in the Society, or question agitated therein, foreign to its object and the good government thereof, as expressed in the Law by which it is authorized.

ART. 9. On questions to be decided by a Majority of Votes, the President shall only vote when they are equally divided.
