

Catholic Church, and any person ceasing to be in communion with the said Roman Catholic Church shall cease to be a member of the corporation hereby created.

4. The corporation shall have power to appoint a President, a Secretary, and such other officers as they may from time to time deem necessary for the purpose of the Corporation.

5. The said Sainte-Anne College at Church Point shall be held and taken to be a University with all and every the usual privileges of such an institution, and the Directors of said Corporation now or hereby appointed shall have the power and privilege of conferring the degrees of Bachelor, Master and Doctor in the several Arts and Faculties, and may make such by-laws and regulations as they may deem necessary to govern the granting of such degrees and determine the scholastic requirements therefor.

*(Amendment passed in 1893.)*

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GOVERNOR, COUNCIL AND ASSEMBLY, AS FOLLOWS:—

1. The Corporation shall have power to take by donation, deed, devise, bequest, purchase or otherwise howsoever, and to hold real and personal property, and to sell and convey the same.
