MONDAY, MARCH 24, 1931... THE GRAND RIVER QUESTION... 'It is but a truth to say that the Grand is in a class by itself because of the territory it traverses—the most important industrial section in Ontario. It has been made what it is, a stagnant stream in summer and a torrential river in the spring, by the methods employed to make the most of the drainage legislation of the Legislature. Under present conditions it is impossible to provide in Galt, Paris and Brantford, especially in this town, a safe outlet for the annual discharge. Here the river runs through the heart of the town flanked for a distance of a mile by large stone buildings, the levels of which were adapted to the needs of the day.
