Sir Frederick Williams-Taylor, who as general manager of the Bank of Montreal, negotiated the forty-five million dollar loan for the Canadian Government in the New York money market in July, has been the responsible factor in bringing more capital to the Dominion than any other individual, says J. H. Hodgins in The Financial Times.

During those years Canada rolled up the monumental sum of £246,278,200 borrowed entirely from British investors. Of this capital acquired, it is safe to assume that fifty per cent was negotiated through the Bank of Montreal in London. Several from here attended the Allies' Patriotic Fair held in Norwich last week. Mr. Ross Burtis, Preston, spent the week-end at home.

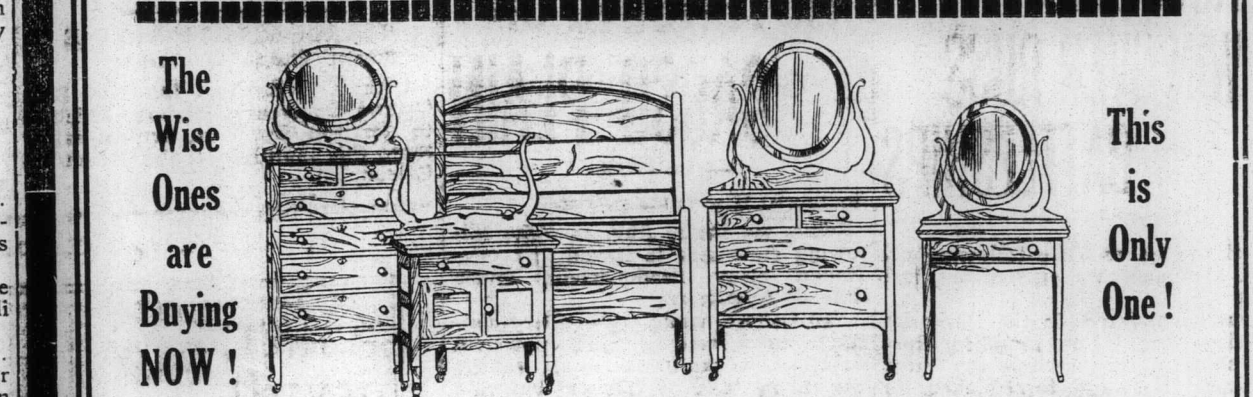
