Hostilities Begun!

Collision Between Korean and Japanese Troops at Seoul.

The Wellman Arctic Expedition Reported to Have Perished.

Minnie Palmer's Suit Settled.
LONDON, July 24.—The trial of the divorce suit of John P. Rogers against Minnie Palmer has been abandoned, a private settlement having been reached by the parties.

Steamer Sunk Off Folkstone.
LONDON, July 24.—The steamer Mount Stewart was sunk off Folkstone this morning by coming into collision with the steamer Trinidad. The crew of the Mount Stewart were saved.

"That Blessed Baby."
LONDON, July 25.—The Truth says that the Queen has ordered the Danish artist Vitzthum, who painted the Duke of York's wedding, to paint the christening of the Duke's son. Truth is indignant over the perpetual slighting of English artists.

All Were Lost.
ATHENS, July 24.—A boat carrying M. Boudoris, royal master of ceremonies; Mme. Boudoris and M. Mochakis, the Crown Prince's secretary, was upset in a storm in the Bay of Phaleron Sunday. All the occupants of the boat are supposed to have been drowned.

Results of the Italian Victory.
ROME, July 24.—Advices from Kassala say that hundreds of Mahdists have surrendered to the Italians at that place, and report hundreds of their comrades are wandering about in the marshes of the Atbara River in a starving condition.

One of Sara's "Fetchings" Plays.
LONDON, July 24.—While Sara Bernhardt was playing in "The Dame aux Camelias" last evening in Theatre Royal, Glasgow, a man ran to the stage from the wings in the fourth act, and seizing her by the shoulders endeavored to rescue her from Duval.

The Flying Machine Fell.
BRUSSELS, July 24.—Engineer Lillenthal, of Lichtenhede, recently constructed a flying machine with which he has succeeded in reaching considerable height. While practicing on Sunday last the wings of the machine collapsed at an altitude of 200 feet, and he fell to the ground. His fall was broken somewhat, but he was badly injured.

Board of Trade Report on Strikes.
LONDON, July 24.—A report just laid before the Board of Trade shows that in 1892 there were no less than 692 strikes in the United Kingdom, with, in addition to these, eight lockouts. Capital amounting \$95,000,000 was laid idle, and 511 establishments were closed. Wages lost to labor amounted to \$2,500,000, and aid from sympathetic unions was sacrificed to the amount of \$800,000.

Royal Honors for a Bruiser.
DUBLIN, July 24.—James J. Corbett, the American pugilist, paid a visit yesterday to the town of Ballinrobe, county Mayo, where his father was born. He was greeted at the station by thousands of people, who literally carried him to his hotel. In the afternoon he gave a performance for the benefit of a chapel which his uncle, Rev. James Corbett, is building. Excursion trains were run to the town during the afternoon to convey the crowds of people anxious to see the American champion. The evening he was entertained at a reception in the town hall, where he was presented with an address of welcome and overwhelmed with bouquets.

Bounced the Reporters.
PARIS, July 24.—In the Chamber of Deputies during the debate on article 5, which imposes certain restrictions upon the press M. Denoix, Republican, made a remark which elicited a chorus of protesting "oh, oh's" from the press gallery. The expression was immediately followed by a burst of applause from the Socialists, and the confusion became general. The acting president, Vice-President M. de Mahey, ordered the press gallery to be cleared. This was done, but several members of the press refused to go voluntarily, and they were removed forcibly. The confusion became so prolonged that several members demanded that the sitting be suspended. A vote was taken on a motion to suspend the sitting, and it was rejected 348 to 120.

Fighting in Corea.
LONDON, July 24.—The Japanese Minister has official information confirming the report of an engagement between Korean and Japanese troops at Seoul. There is no doubt in the minds of members of the Japanese legation that the attack upon the Japanese garrison was instigated by the Chinese.

SHANGHAI, July 24.—The British Charge d'Affaires at Tokio has wired the British consul here that Japan has agreed to treat Shanghai as outside the sphere of action in any war in which she may engage with China.

Mr. Tatenno, the Japanese Minister at Washington today received a telegram from his Government saying that Korean troops had made an uncalculated attack upon the Japanese soldiers stationed at Seoul, and that their fire had been returned by the Japanese troops.

A dispatch to the Central News from Shanghai says: When war has been declared the non-combatant powers will exact a pledge that the treaty ports shall be

exempted from attack, their respective squadrons combining to insure the fulfillment of the pledge. China has embargoed the fleet of the China Merchants Company, the vessels to be employed as transport, when needed. Negotiations are proceeding with other vessel owners. The partial blockade here is aimed only against passenger and cargo steamers owned in Yokohama, Nagasaki and Kobi. Some owners propose to sail their vessels under the American flag.

The Viceroy at Tien-Tsin claims that there are military and naval munitions in the naval factories sufficient for six months' campaign. The Viceroy's camp in the vicinity contains 30,000 infantry and cavalry, and additions arrive daily. Another force will shortly be dispatched to Corea.

Disaster to an Arctic Expedition.
LONDON, July 24.—The Standard prints a letter from Carl Siewers, in which he says he has received advices from Norway leaving no doubt that the Wellman Arctic expedition is lost. Other advices have been received confirming the general belief that the members of the expedition have perished.

Arctic sailors report that the flow of pack ice in the Arctic Seas this summer has been so plentiful and dense that no vessel could live after being caught in it. They are unanimously of opinion that the Ragnvald Jarl has been crushed in the ice and believe that the chance of any members of the expedition having been saved is very remote. Even if they managed to get on an iceflow they would be in a dangerous position and not able to survive long.

Mr. Fildon, the owner of the yacht Saide, a short time ago received news that Prof. Oyen, the geologist, who accompanied the Wellman expedition, was in distress. Mr. Fildon ordered the Saide to Dr. Oyen's island, where Oyen's dog piloted the Saide's party to the professor's quarters. He was found in bed in an almost dying condition. Upon a table in the professor's quarters was found a letter containing bitter reproaches against Wellman, whom he accused of having left him in the lurch. The Saide also reported that Prof. Oyen was so badly provisioned when he was found that his early death was a matter of certainty. But in spite of his sufferings the professor refused to be taken off Dane's Island, insisting upon remaining there faithful to his trust, even though death was the result of his continuing at his post in his Arctic solitude.

New York, July 24.—The North Pole expedition, with Walter Wellman at its head, which is now believed to have been lost, left Tromsø, Norway, May 24, 1894. They sailed for Spitzbergen on the steamship Ragnvald Jarl. The intention was to take what Wellman considered the true highway to the north, namely, that in which the influence of the Gulf Stream carved out the ice in the Northern Sea. The expedition included Astronomer Owen B. French, of the United States coast and geodetic survey; Franklin, an American scientist; Oyen, a geologist from Christiania; Alme, a meteorologist, and two sportsmen and runners from the University of Christiania. They were last heard of at Dane's Island, off the northwest coast of Spitzbergen, where Prof. Oyen remained to guard and to provision the depot established there.

The Saide is now at Granton. Fildon, the naturalist, writes that there are reasons for fearing that the Ragnvald Jarl is never with ice or that she has already come to grief, though that need not involve the loss of the explorers. He advises Wellman's friends to send supplies via Tromsø to Pine's Island, where they will arrive in September.

The Standard this morning, referring to the fate of the Wellman expedition, says that it cannot be denied that it was an ill-divided plan of inexperienced men to beat the record.

A Printer's "Fat Take"
FAIRBANKS, Minn., July 24.—Henry S. Bretz, a compositor of the Fairbanks Republican for the past twelve years, received notice today from a Michigan man that he has fallen heir to a part of \$40,000,000 which was left by some relatives in Germany.

Five Firemen Hurt.
NEW YORK, July 24.—The five-story building at 291 Walker street, occupied by drygoods merchants, was damaged with its contents to the extent of \$40,000 this evening by fire. The fire was caused by an explosion. Five firemen were slightly injured by falling while fighting the fire.

Twenty-Eight Houses Burned.
MONTREAL, July 24.—In today's fire there was no loss of life, although there were several narrow escapes. The cottages destroyed were occupied by laboring men. Altogether there were 28 houses reduced to ashes between 3 o'clock and daylight. Each of these contained at least one family, and some two.

Where Beef Is Dear.
WASHINGTON, July 24.—Owing to the hay famine last year in Switzerland all surplus stock was killed, and now there is a great scarcity. Beef brings on the hoof, \$15.40 per 220 pounds, and dressed beef \$40.38 per 220 pounds. The consul suggests that American live stock shippers communicate with the president of the Swiss Butchers' Association.

Three Drowned.
WILKESBARRE, Pa., July 24.—At an early hour this morning nine men who had been attending a Polish picnic at Hanover Park attempted to cross the Susquehanna River in a small rowboat. When about 75 feet from the Plymouth shore all the occupants were thrown into the river. Six of them managed to swim ashore, but the other three perished. All of them were Polish.

One of Frick's Houses Blown Up.
CONNELSVILLE, Pa., July 26.—A house owned by the H. C. Frick Coal Company at Lesingring, No. 3, was blown up this morning by dynamite. Andrew Carstak, a deserter from the strikers' ranks, was sleeping on the first floor and escaped uninjured. The mob stole over \$200 worth of sticks of dynamite last night and explosions are expected. Additional deputies have been placed on guard at the coke plants.

Disaster in a Match Factory.
TRENTON, N. J., July 24.—Three persons were injured by an explosion at the Trenton match factory this afternoon. The injured are: George Tinnal, foot nearly torn off and face cut; Clara Jewell, badly bruised; Edward Ely, arm and leg burned. The damage to the building will amount to several thousand dollars. The explosion was due to the overheating of about five gallons of compound which is used in making the heads of matches.

"FORESTERS' ISLAND."

Big Society Demonstration Deseronto.

Inauguration of the Island Bought by Dr. Oronhyatekha.

DESERONTO, Ont., July 24.—One of the largest gatherings ever held here on the occasion of the dedication of Foresters' Island, which is owned by the supreme chief ranger of the Independent Order of Foresters. The island formerly known as Capt. John's Island, and then purchased by Dr. Oronhyatekha a short time ago, was in a very rough state. Since last March work has been put forward, and now the island is one of the prettiest spots on the Bay of Quinte.

Some 2,500 people were present to witness the ceremony of dedication and the sports which had been prepared by the doctor and his wife. After the invocation and the reading of the address by the band stand, where addresses were delivered by Dr. Oronhyatekha, Hon.
