210 SUNDAY BLAZE

Fire at Noon in the East End—Buildings Outward-Narrow Escape. A still alarm at 11:30 yesterday morning brought the brigades from Bolton-avenue, Wilton-avenue and Berkeley-street to Joseph White's wheat store at Harris and Queen-street east. Fire had originated in the rear amongst the stored hay. There was a very serious blaze, and despite the firm's efforts the entire stock and the building were burned. The loss is estimated at from \$7500 to \$8000. The insurance, which was in the Hand in Hand Company, was only \$3000. There were three horses in the stable; two of these were rescued with difficulty; the third, an animal valued at \$150, was burned to death.
