CURLERS WILL WELCOME ABERDEEN

Ontario Association Officers Arrange to
Entertain His Excellency on
Granite Ice Next Friday.

Lord Aberdeen will be in Toronto next
week and his loyal followers of the Granite
Ice rink have arranged to give the Governor-
General a most royal welcome.

A meeting of the Executive Committee of
the Ontario Curling Association was held
yesterday afternoon, when arrangements
were made for a 6-rink contest in the
Granite Rink, on Friday, Jan. 5.

In a letter to Secretary Russell, the noble
currier from Scotland, stated that he might
not be as familiar with the "ice" and "curl"
as his Canadian friends, but he would
accept the pleasant duties of skipping a
rink on the date named. Aberdeen will
have on his rink W. H. Egan, M.L.A., the
well-known Belleville currier, as vice-skip,
President Matthews of Barrie, No. 2, and
the veteran Thomas McKeown as lead.

Mr. J. S. Russell writes of the event as
follows:

"Probably the most interesting curling
match ever arranged in Canada will be
played in the Granite Rink here on Friday
Jan. 5, beginning at 3 p.m., weather per-
mitting.

"His Excellency the Governor-General,
patron of the Ontario Curling Association,
with the officers-beaters, will contend against
six rinks of the city curlers.

"As the officers-beaters of the association
have won their positions primarily by their
skill in the game, and only secondarily by
their administrative abilities, and the city
clubs have to select only 6 out of about
100 rinks, there is certain to be an exhibition
of the finest curling and the keenest of
competitions. It is also most probable that
the Duke of Ave, a son of Lord Dufferin, the
first patron of the association, will also take
part in the contest. May Jack Frost be propi-
tious."

Scott's Curriers' Visit Postponed.

It is most likely that the proposed visit
of Scotch curlers to Canada will not take
place this winter. Three rinks were expected,
but the correspondence shows the Scotch-
men look for a good portion of their ex-
penses from curlers on this side of the

THE FLIGHT OF MARTIN COSTELLO.

The Pugilist Wanted in Indiana Refuses
to Toronto—He Didn't Want to

the state penitentiary at hard labor.

"I don't think I committed a very serious
offence and it looked as if I would have to
go behind the bars," said the big fellow
yesterday in the Athletic restaurant, "and
as an ordinary individual I preferred my
liberty, so I have come to visit you for a
while and I will not go back until granted my
liberty."
