## FRENCH WORK.

In connection with the French work in Montreal, there are at present two day schools—one at the west, the other at the east end of the city.

The teachers report an average attendance of sixty scholars at one, and twenty-five at the other of these schools.

In almost every case, one parent, at least, is a Roman Catholic, and belonging as they do to the poorer classes, their children would not attend the public schools, and if it were not for the opportunity afforded by our mission, would be growing up without instruction either in matters relating to this life, or the more important things of the life to come.
