United States bank notes, silver and stamps (values up to 15c.) are accepted at face to any amount.

Canadian correspondents will find postal notes convenient for small remittances, but waere these cannot be readily obtained, 1-c. and 1c. stamps will be accepted.

Correspondents in other British Colonies until farther notice may remit in stamps to any amount. Sets (½c. to 25c.) and new or provisional issues are preferred.

From correspondents in Foreign Countries we will accept current unused stamps up to \$1.00, if in sets of at least five values and well centred.
