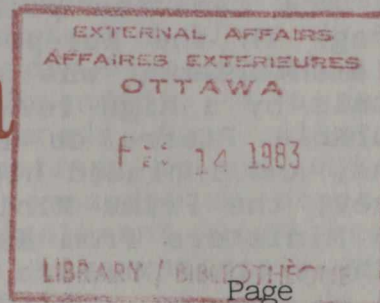

CANADA/EC CONSULTATIONS AND INDUSTRIAL COOPERATION

At the beginning of November a high level delegation from the European Commission travelled to Ottawa for the 19th round of semi-annual consultations between Canada and the EC. During the same week meetings were held of the Sub-Committee on Industrial Cooperation and the General and Preparatory Sub-Committee established under the Canada/EC Framework Agreement for Commercial and Economic Cooperation, signed in 1976.

The participants in the semi-annual consultations reviewed the international economic situation and a wide range of multilateral trade issues. They exchanged information on agricultural, energy and regional policy developments in Canada and the Community, and addressed a range of bilateral issues including recent anti-dumping and countervailing duty actions in Canada, footwear quotas, provincial liquor board practices, implementation of the bilateral fisheries agreement, trade in seal products, newsprint and cheese.
