government will, following a request from an importer, examine a lot of fish for export to determine if it meets the requirements of the importing country. The individual requirements of these countries are outlined in a procedural manual for inspection personnel. If the product meets the necessary requirements, a certificate is issued.

This export certification program promotes the international sale of Canadian fish products and assures exporters that their products will be acceptable to the importing country.

Inspection laboratories

The 23 fish inspection laboratories across Canada are situated in major fish-producing areas.

Analyses for product safety involve tests for the presence of harmful bacteria, contaminants such as heavy metals and pesticide residues, and paralytic shellfish poison. Products are regularly tested bacteriologically, chemically and organoleptically (by the senses) for odour, flavour, texture and such defects as bones, bruises, scales, blood spots and foreign material. All fish products must be completely wholesome — free from taint and decomposition.

Laboratory staff regularly check to ensure that products for which grade standards have been established comply with all regulatory requirements and thereby enable the field inspection staff to certify Canadian fish products for the export market.

Canada's fish inspection activities — which cover vessels, plants, unloading, holding and handling sites, and transportation equipment — ensure that only the country's finest products reach international markets.
