We have worked together in recent peacekeeping operations in Cambodia, Bosnia and Rwanda. I have stated my conviction that our two countries will continue to meet their international responsibilities through mutual support. In the bilateral area, our relations are just as fruitful and friendly, and with your help I intend to increase them, in order to promote our joint political, commercial and cultural interests. Finally, may I express the hope that you will visit Canada at a mutually convenient time.
