His Excellency Turgut Menemencioglu today presented to the Governor-General his Letters of Credence as Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Turkey to Canada. The ceremony took place at Government House at 11:30 a.m. The Chief of Protocol, Mr. H. F. Feaver, presented the Ambassador to His Excellency the Governor-General. Mr. Henry F. Mr. Turgut Menemencioglu was born in 1914. He is a graduate of Robert College (Istanbul) and Law College (Geneva) and entered the diplomatic service in 1939. In addition he has served on the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe in Geneva, the Permanent Mission to United Nations, New York and, has recently been Deputy Permanent Representative to the United Nations, New York.

Mr. Menemencioglu attended the Bandung Conference in Indonesia as Turkish Delegate.
