Where the Minister is satisfied that any person (in this section called the "Contractor") has failed or is likely to fail to carry out in a businesslike and efficient manner the whole or any part of a contract to manufacture or produce any munitions of war or supplies or to construct or carry out any defence project, or has failed to keep proper and detailed accounts and records of the cost of the work performed under any such contract, the Minister may 10 authorize any other person to carry on, until the Minister otherwise directs, and subject to and in accordance with the provisions hereinafter contained in this Act, the whole or any part of the Contractor's business."
