QUESTIONS PASSED AS ORDERS FOR RETURNS

CONSTRUCTION AND ALTERATION OF BUILDINGS

Mr. Fulton:

1. How many contracts have been entered into in each of the three years ending December 31, 1952 for construction, alteration, etc. of buildings, or other installations, by each department or agency of government (except the departments of defence and defence production and any agency thereof, or crown corporation under the jurisdiction of the minister thereof, and excluding con-

tracts having to do with atomic energy matters) without advertising or calling for tenders?

2. In the case of each such contract, what is (a) the date of the contract; (b) the location of the property (giving city or town and street number where applicable); (c) the name of the building (where applicable); (d) the department or departments or crown company or agency to be accommodated or other description of the purpose of the building as applicable; (e) the name and address of the builder or contractor; (f) the agreed cost of construction; (g) the final cost of construction; (h) the builders or contractors fee where the contract was awarded on a fixed fee basis?
