A. For admission to the B.A. course.

English.

Latin or Greek.

Mathematics or a third foreign language.

Any three of the following:-

1. History.

2. Latin or Greek (the one not already taken).

3. French.

4. German.

5. Science (Physics or Chemistry or Biology).

Candidates cannot substitute a third foreign language for Mathematics unless they have passed in the Mathematics prescribed for Junior Matriculation.

B. For admission to the B.Sc. course.

1. Chemistry.

2. English.

3. French.

4. German.

5. Mathematics.

6. Physics.

C. For admission to the B.Com. course.

1. English.

2. Mathematics.

3. French or Spanish or German.

4. Accountancy.

Any ~~three~~ two of the following:-

5. Latin or Greek.

6. French or Spanish or German (one not already taken).

7. Physics or Biology or Chemistry.

8. History.

These examinations may be taken in two parts but candidates must complete the requirements within thirteen (13) months of the first attempt.
