With reference to our former conversations regarding an appeal to the Shawinigan Water & Power Company to help McGill University supply increased facilities to our Electrical Engineering Department, let me say that at yesterday's meeting of our Board of Governors I was given authority to proceed with the erection of the building contemplated. This authority was given on the assumption that we would receive some assistance from the Montreal, Light, Heat & Power and from your Company.
