VISITORS.

I.

No visitor shall be admitted into this Lodge unless he be personally known, recommended, or well vouched for, after due examination by one of the Brethren present, and every visitor during his continuance in the Lodge is strictly to conform to the Bye Laws thereof.

II.

No Brother, who is not a subscribing Member to some Lodge, shall be permitted to visit this Lodge more than once during his secession from the Craft, sojourners excepted.

III.

No Brother who has been concerned in making a Mason clandestinely, or in a Lodge which is not a regular Lodge, or who has assisted in forming any new Lodge without the Grand Master's authority, shall be admitted a visitor to this Lodge.
