Washington, June 13.—Complete repulse of heavy enemy attacks northwest of Chateau Thierry with heavy losses for the Germans was reported tonight in General Pershing's communique. The American lines, advanced yesterday by taking the last of the German positions in Belleau Wood, remained intact.

The communique follows: Yesterday afternoon our troops northwest of Chateau Thierry captured the last of the German positions in the Belleau Wood, taking fifty prisoners and a number of machine guns and trench mortars, in addition to those on the preceding day.

Early this morning the enemy launched heavy attacks on a front of more than one and one-half miles on the line Bel-

jeau-Bourches. The attacks, which were preceded by intense artillery preparations and accompanied by a heavy barrage, broke down completely, leaving our positions intact. The heaviest of the enemy were very severe.

Last night our aviators bombed with good effect the station of Dommary, Baroncourt, northwest of Metz. All our machines returned.

MAJ. H. M. MOWAT UPHOLDS UNIONISM

Ward Six Liberal-Conservatives Told About Last Session.

HUGH CLARK IS HEARD SAYS FARMERS' DEPUTATION NOT REPRESENTATIVE OF ALL ONTARIO.

Justifying every action on the part of the Union government at the last session and giving an account of their stewardship, Major H. M. Mowat, member for Parkdale, took the members of Ward Six Liberal-Conservative Association into their confidence at a fairly well attended meeting in Bonar Hall, corner of College street and Lansdowne avenue, last night.

Major Mowat said he had received two impressions of the last session. One was that Canada could not be properly governed thru Union government, and the second was that Canada was safe in the hands of the present prime minister.

He spoke of the farmers' deputation to Ottawa and remarked that no party government could have understood the demands made. However, the Union government had been thinking of winning or losing votes, the farmers were a prosperous-looking group.

He said, "Three-quarters of the farmers had changed their opinions after the interview and had seen the conditions from another viewpoint. Some had said they were ashamed when they understood, that each spent \$50, and giving them \$200 each, which might better have stayed in their own pockets."
